



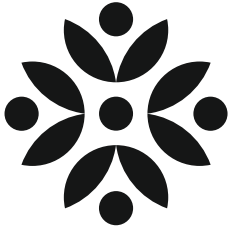

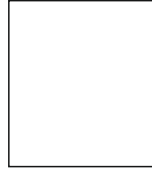

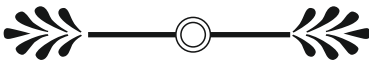

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Students should wear complete, clean uniform daily.
2. Students are expected to speak in ENGLISH at all time in the school campus.
3. Class rooms and the school campus should be kept neat and tidy.
4. All assignments should be regularly completed and submitted as directed by the teachers.
5. Students are responsible for the safe custody of their books and all other belongings.
6. Running, playing or shouting inside the class room or school building is not allowed.
7. School begins with Assembly and students are required to be on time for Assembly. Habitual delay to the school will be dealt with disciplinary action.
8. Any damage caused to the school property or that of other pupils will have to be repaired.
9. Any serious breach of discipline including discourtesy and disrespect to any of the staff members in any way, will be viewed seriously.
10. Students should actively participate in all the co-curricular activities conducted by the school from time to time.
11. Students should walk in a single line while changing class room, going to playground, coming out of class room to leave for home.

**NOTE TO THE PARENTS**

Co-operation between Parents and school will go along in the proper development of our students. Parents are earnestly required to see that their children are systematic in their study habits at home and are regular in preparing their lessons. So full co-operation of the parents is earnestly solicited.

1. Parents / Guardians are not suppose to contact pupils and teachers without the permission of the Principal during School hours.
2. Any complaints concerning the school matters should be brought to the notice of the Principal.
3. Withdrawal of children from the classes for mere social function is discouraged, as it breaks the continuity of their studies, which is essential for the progress.
4. Achievement Record / Progress Reports issued should be duly signed by the parents and returned to the class teacher.
5. Parents / Guardians are specially requested to notify the school of any change in their address.
6. Parents are requested to check the School Diary to see if there are any communications from the Teachers / Principal.
7. Parents / Guardians who wish to discuss the welfare and progress of their children should meet the Principal or the Class Teacher after obtaining the permission. Parents can meet respective Class Teacher at the office between 03.40 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. on all working days except Saturday.
8. Parents should watch whether your child comes to the school on time and goes back home on time.
9. Identify and encourage the co-curricular talents and sports skills of your child. Latent abilities should also be given much encouragement and consideration.
10. Pay the School fees on time. Fine will be collected for delayed payment of school fees. Fee once paid will not be refunded.

### **ABSENCE / LEAVE**

### **ASSESSMENT / EVALUATION**

There will be continuous and comprehensive evaluation extending throughout the academic year. More focus will be on empowerment through learning, rather than passing the exams. Performance in tests and examination and the regular work done by pupil throughout year will be considered for promotion to upper class. No retest / exams shall be conducted if the pupil remains absent for the test / exams. Achievement Record / showing the progress of the pupil will be issued from time to time. The positive attributes and latent competencies will be systematically evaluated for improvement.
